5.	Whichever scenario is used, you must ensure that anything that re-enters the farm does not pose an infection risk. 6.	Retain and file your collection tickets						

- If you become infected with PED you must inform your collector so they can re-schedule your collection to last in the week, and take necessary precautions to prevent onward spread of the virus.

Considerations for Fallen Stock Collectors:

- Collection vehicles must be kept meticulously clean (see SOP 7) this also includes the cab and driver.
- Plan one-way traffic routes at the collectors yard to ensure dirty vehicle in and clean vehicle out.
- Vehicles should be washed and disinfected every time before leaving the yard.
- Always adhere to the unit's biosecurity protocols (see SOP 4 and 5 for more detail).
- If collecting from a PED positive unit, this must be the last collection in the day, ideally in the week, and extra attention should be paid to cleaning and disinfecting the vehicle once back in the yard.
